



San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

The Lake View Neighborhood houses the Foster Communication Coliseum and San Angelo Fairgrounds. The Coliseum contains an indoor arena with the capacity of approximately 6,500 people and provides 2362 outdoor parking spaces. The Coliseum is a renowned venue for the San Angelo Rodeo and Livestock Show, which is one of the city's key annual tourist attractions whereby approximately 50,000 people attend. The majority of the western border of this neighborhood is bounded by N. Chadbourne Street. Lakeview High School is also located in this neighborhood. Key street networks include N. Chadbourne Street to the west and southwest, 29th Street to the south, and Armstrong Street to the east.
